Notice of Intention to Install Controlled Crossings (No. 4) 2026

1. Alder Rd: Install a parallel crossing to the north of its junction with Recreation Rd.
2. Bourne Valley Rd: Install a parallel crossing north of its junction with the Bourne Valley Roundabout.
3. Bourne Valley Rd: Install a parallel crossing south of its junction with the Bourne Valley Roundabout.
4. Surrey Rd: Install a parallel crossing east of its junction with the Bourne Valley Roundabout.
5. Yarmouth Rd: Relocate the existing crossing by install a parallel crossing on its junction with the Bourne Valley Roundabout.

Notice of Intention to Install Traffic Calming (No. 1) 2026

1. Cromer Rd: outside No. 40 install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 3.5m long (including ramps) for the full width of the carriageway.
2. Recreation Rd: on its junction with Alder Rd, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 14m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
3. Sheringham Rd/Cromer Rd: on its junction, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 30m long on both roads (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
4. Sheringham Rd: outside No. 44, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 3.5m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
5. Sheringham Rd: outside No. 58, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 3.5m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
6. Sheringham Rd: outside Nos. 94 & 96, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 3.5m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
7. Sheringham Rd/Wroxham Rd: on its junction, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 25m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.
8. Wroxham Rd: on its junction with Yarmouth Rd, install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 21m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.

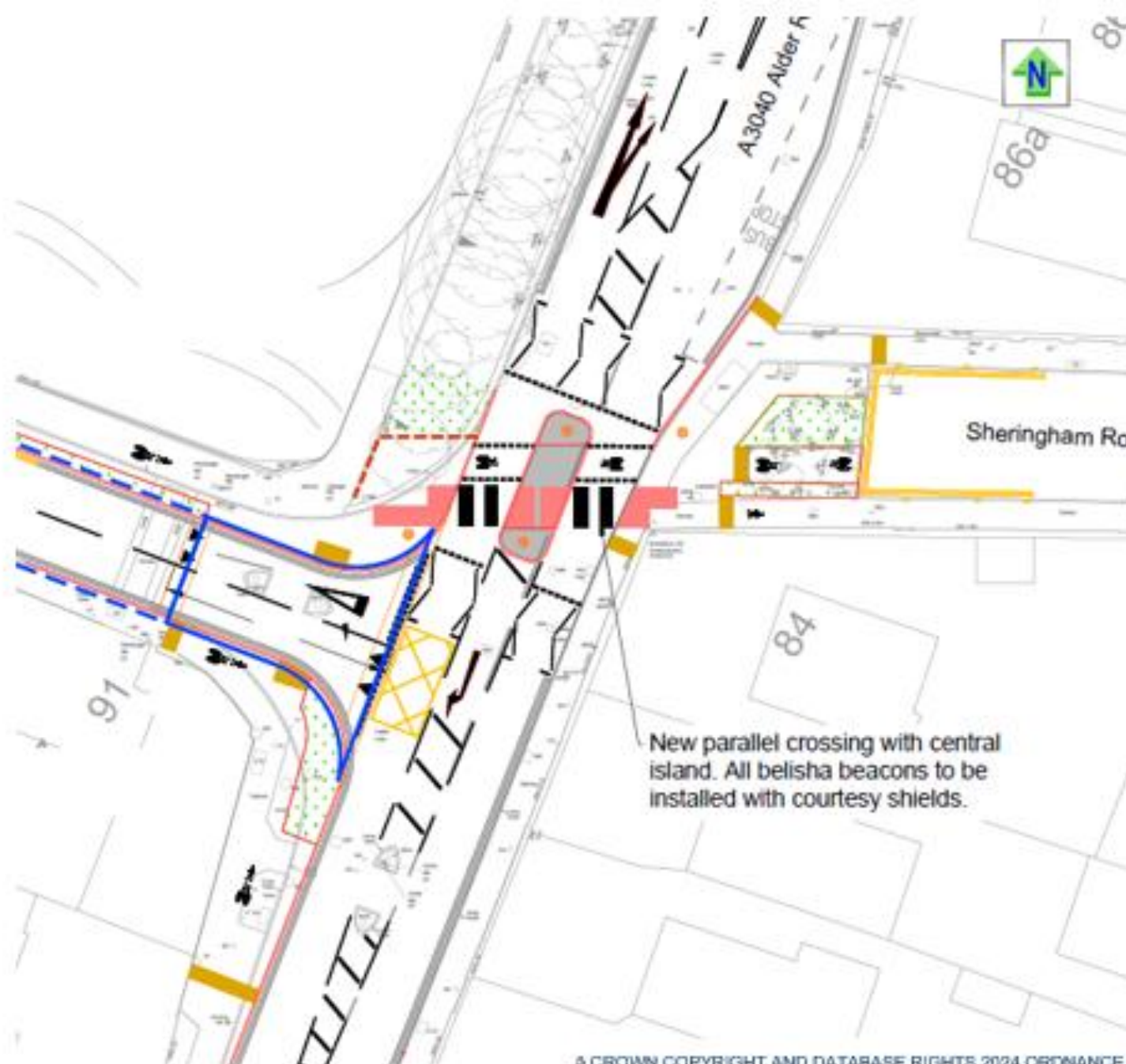

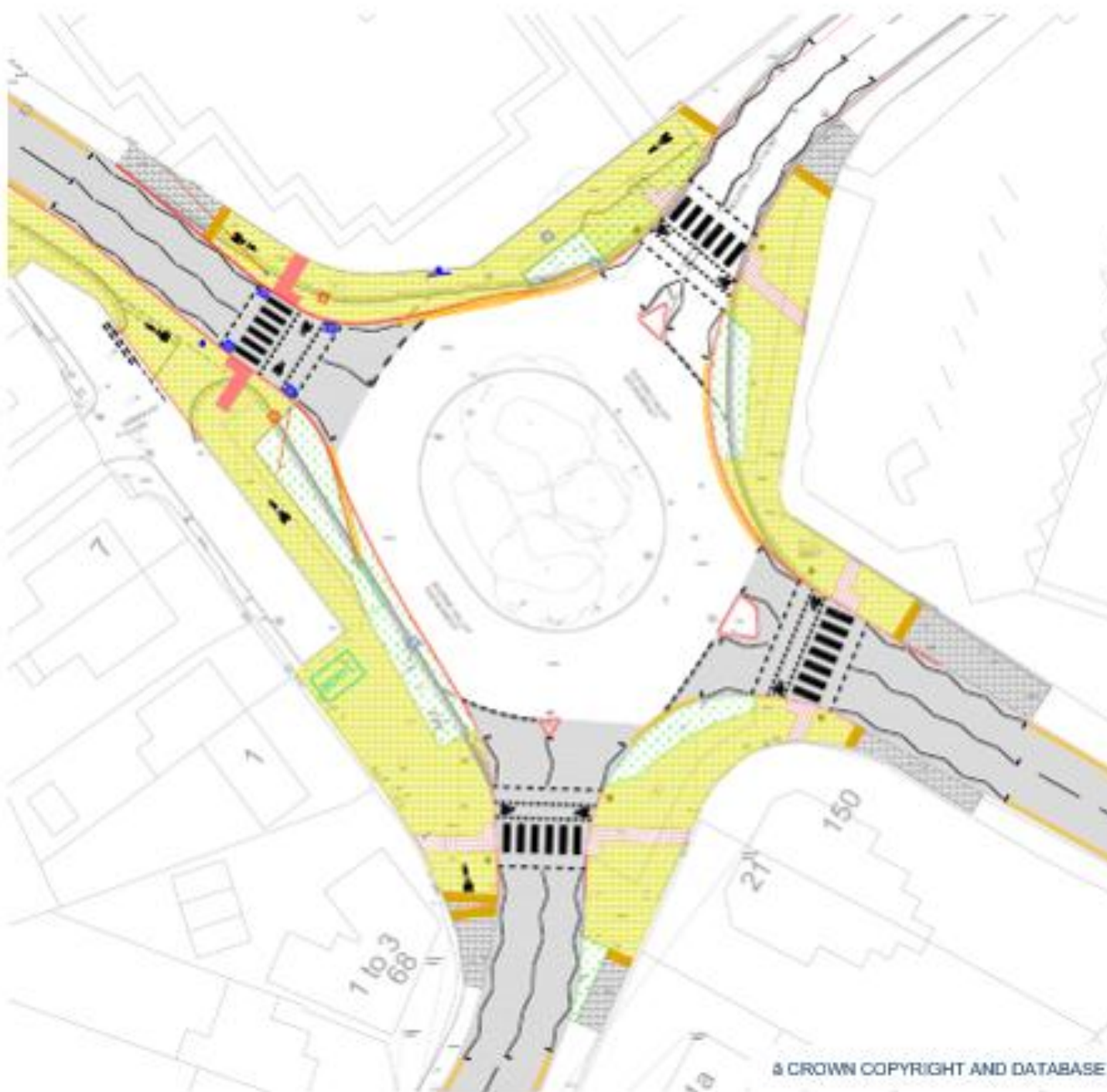
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Proposed Parallel Crossings

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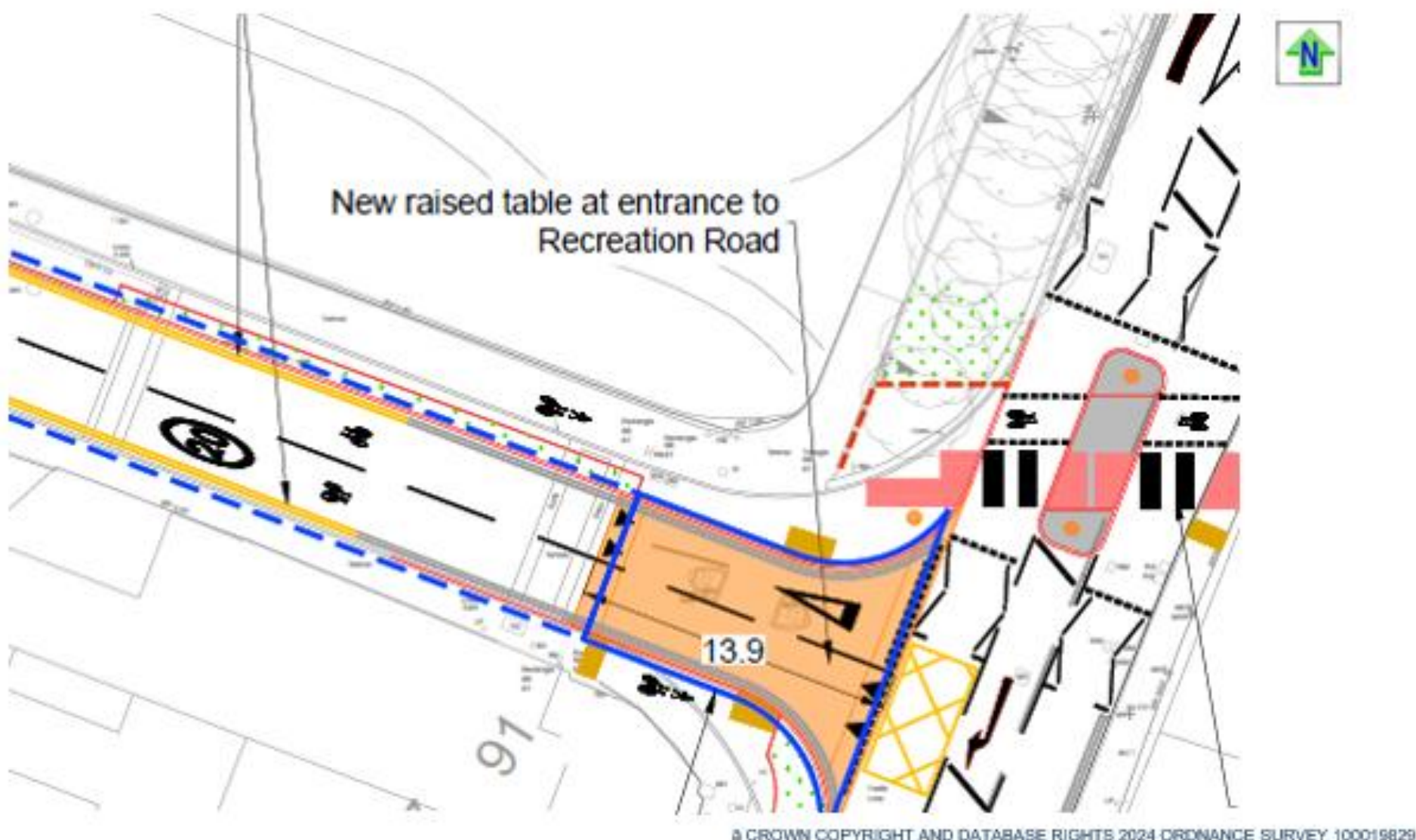
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Recreation Rd: on its junction with Alder Rd: Install a flat top road hump 75mm high, 14m long (including ramps), for the full width of the carriageway.



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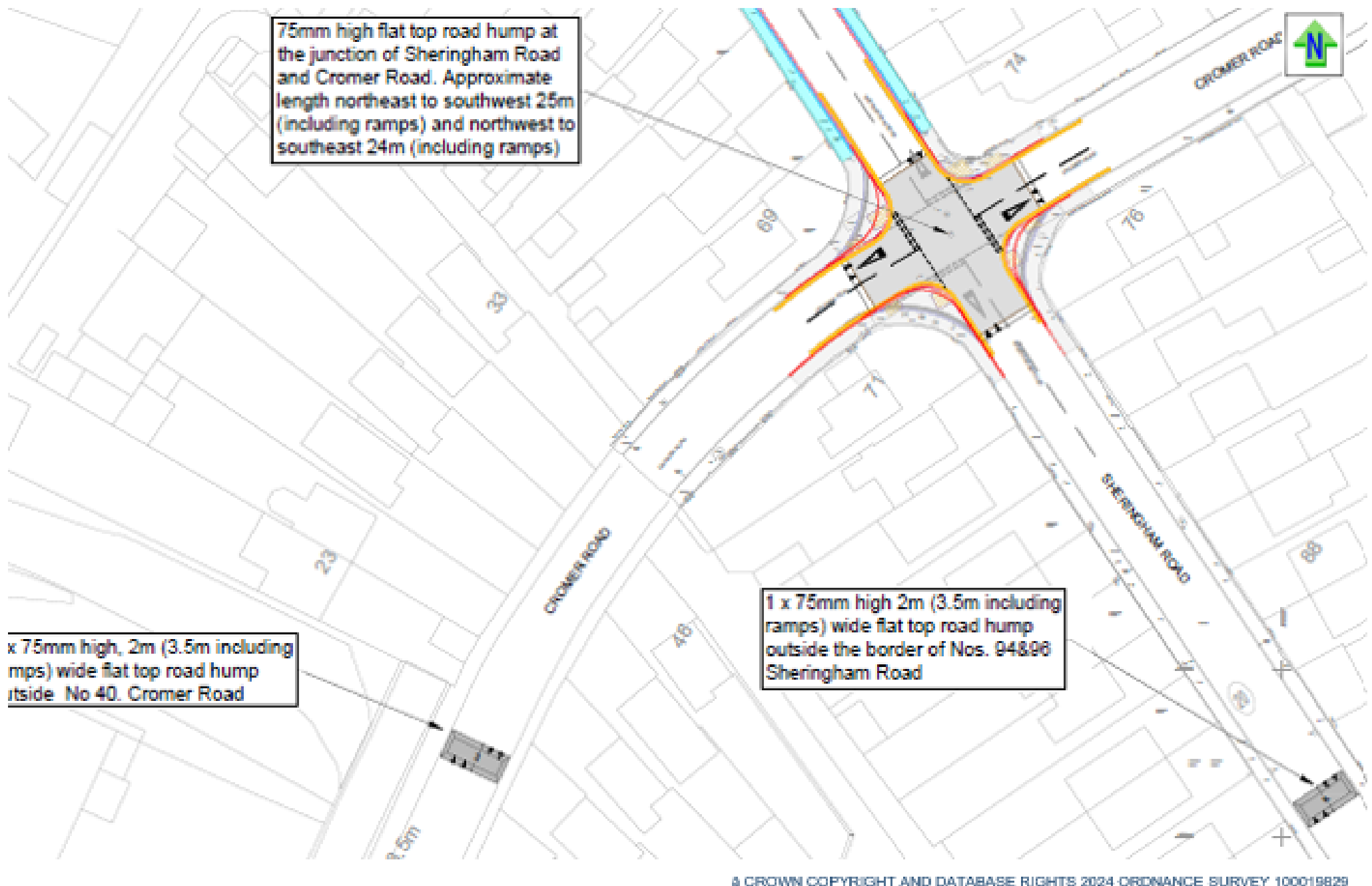
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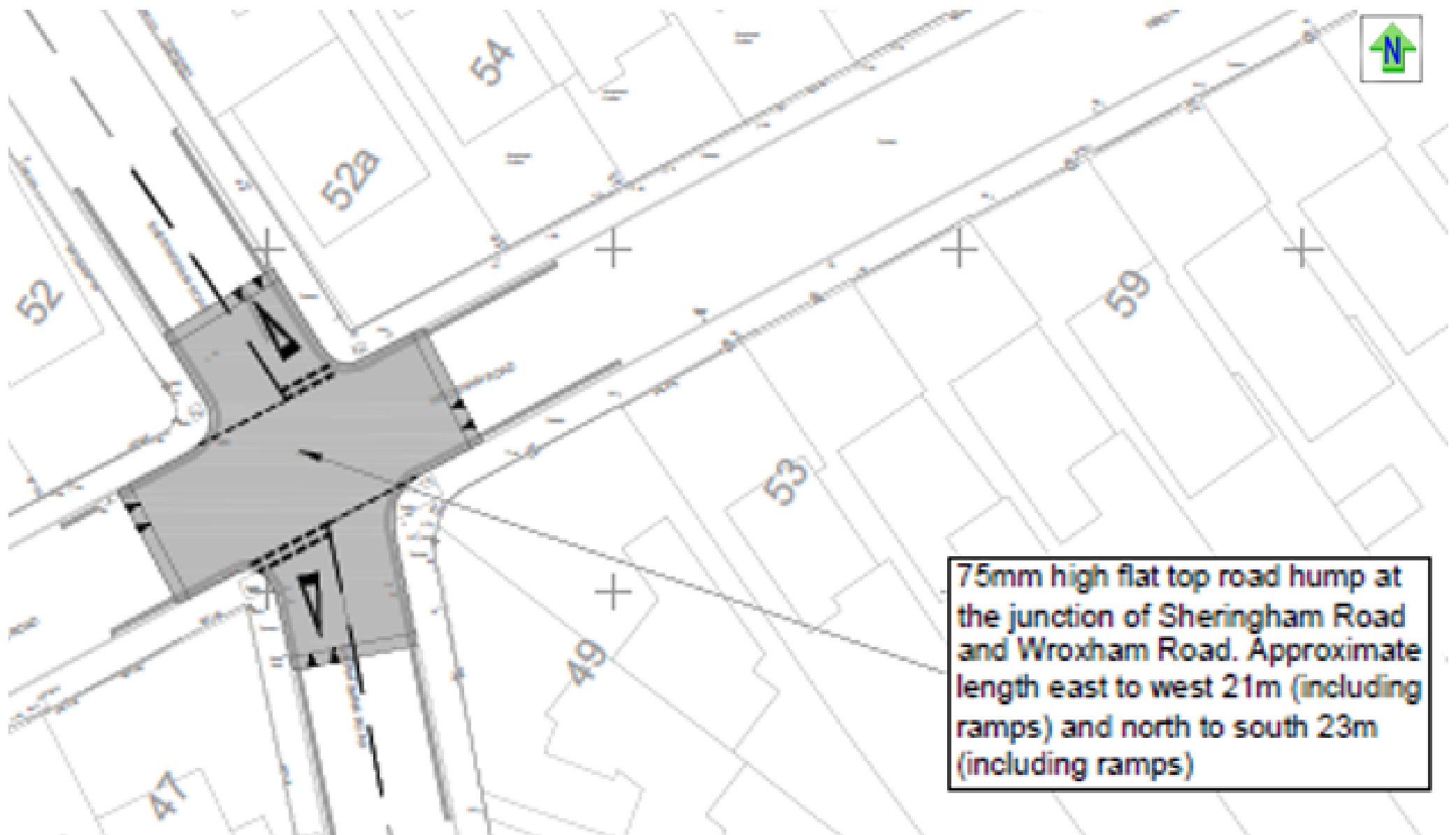
