

East Cliff and Springbourne Neighbourhood Forum Mission Statement incorporating how it meets conditions in Section 61F(5) Schedule 9 of the Town and Country Planning Act

The Neighbourhood Forum's mission is to:

- make East Cliff and Springbourne a sustainable and attractive neighbourhood where there is a balanced mix of housing and population demographic, whilst respecting and preserving the heritage of the area.
- promote local jobs and local shopping opportunities, to reduce the need to travel to work and shop and thus offer environmental benefits including supporting local business.
- create a strong sense of community ownership and safety within a balanced population demographic.

The Neighbourhood Forum has a Written Constitution. Current membership of the forum comprises 23 individuals who live/work within the forum area or is an elected member of BCP Council.

The East Cliff and Springbourne Neighbourhood forum is being established for the express purpose of promoting or improving the social, economic and environmental well-being of the neighbourhood area proposed. Forum membership is open to residents, workers or business owners and those who do business within the forum area.
